## Kanji Characters

In Japanese the numbers 1, 2, and 3 are written using symbols called kanji. There are also kanji meaning "Day" and "Month". You can see these kanji characters below.

1	一
2	二
3	三

Day	日
Month	月

Why not try writing "Day" and "Month" in kanji characters below?


The date of Hina-Matsuri is written like this: 三日三月 because it is on the third day of the third month (March). **How would you write the following dates?**

1st January	
2nd February	
1st March	

Answers: 1st January = 一月一日; 2nd February = 二月二日; 1st March = 三月一日.
